A particular focus is proposed on **deciphering mechanisms of action of TGF- $\beta$  in controlling gut inflammation associated cancer** using both *in vitro* *in vivo* models.

The selected candidate will join a dynamic research team composed of 12 people for a 2 year period potentially extended.
